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## Trendy tea

I've noticed products with white tea popping up all over lately. Bulgari makes a haunting white-tea fragrance, and Origins has created a skin-care line with white-tea extracts that are supposed to offer protection from the environment.

Earlier this year, a New York-based company called Inko's released a bottled white-tea beverage. Brewed from young silvery buds of the *Camellia sinensis* variety called Baiho Yinzhen, the tea comes in a plain version with a hint of ginger, an unsweetened minty tea and a peach-flavored tea. The light-tasting tea is mildly sweetened with fructose crystals and has just under 60 calories a bottle.

Inko's is excited about the tea because recent research indicates it has higher concentrations of the cancer-fighting polyphenols than green tea.
